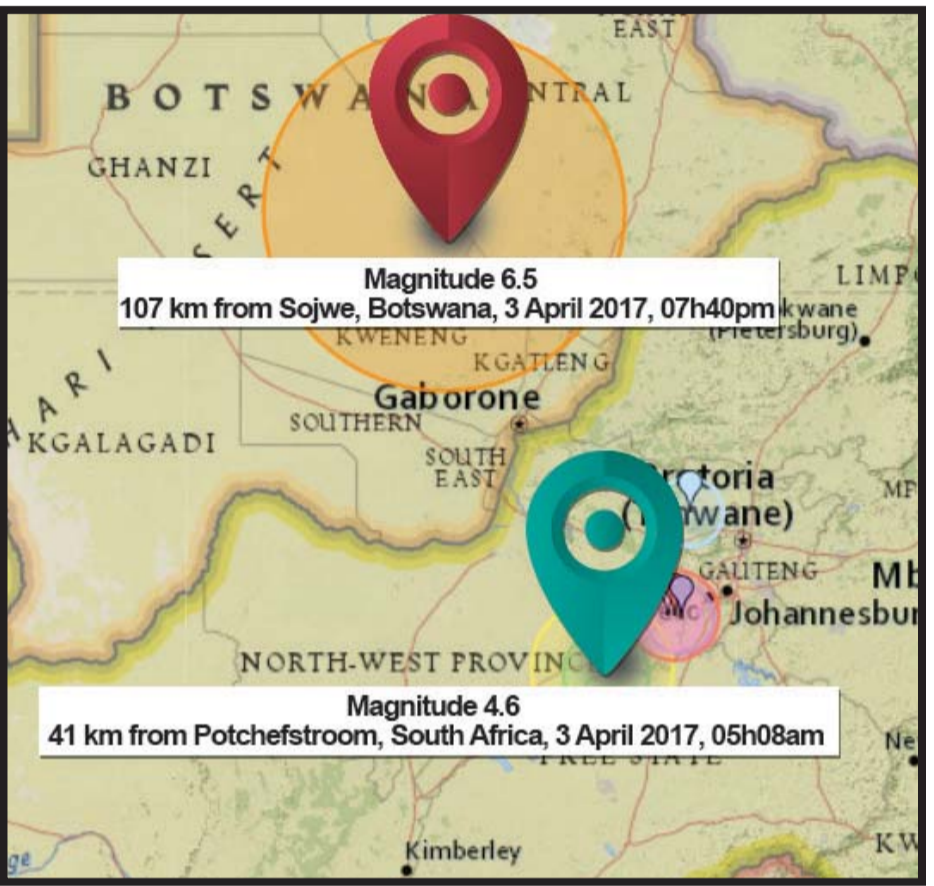




Earthquake in Botswana, shockwaves ripples to South Africa

A strong earthquake of 6.5 magnitude struck in a remote region of Botswana on Monday 3 April 2017, causing tremors and shockwaves in neighbouring South Africa. No early incidents of casualties or damage have been reported. The magnitude 6.5 quake's epicentre was nearly 250km north-northwest of the capital Gaborone at a depth of 12km, a US Geological Survey said. It was felt across Limpopo, Mpumalanga, North

West and large parts of Gauteng, shaking buildings. This is the second tremor to hit South Africa in a 24 hour window. Earlier on 3 April, a 4.6 magnitude earth tremor hit parts of Gauteng and the North West. The tremor, which was 2km deep, was recorded at 05:08 on Monday. It originated near a gold mining area in Klerksdorp.



What to do when an earthquake strikes?

- If you're indoors, stay there. Get under, and hold onto, a desk or table, or stand against an interior wall. Stay clear of exterior walls, glass, heavy furniture, fireplaces and appliances. The kitchen is a particularly dangerous spot. If you're in an office building, stay away from windows and outside walls and do not use the elevator.
- DO NOT stand in a doorway: An enduring earthquake image of California is a collapsed adobe home with the door frame as the only standing part. From this came our belief that a doorway is the safest place to be during an earthquake. True- if you live in an old, unreinforced adobe house or some older wood-frame houses.
- If you're outside, get into the open. Stay clear of buildings, power lines or anything else that could fall on you.
- If you're driving, move the car out of traffic and stop. Avoid parking under or on bridges or overpasses. Try to get clear of trees, light posts, signs and power lines. When you resume driving, watch out for road hazards.
- If you're in a mountainous area, beware of the potential for landslides. Likewise, if you're near the ocean, be aware that tsunamis are associated with large earthquakes. Get to high ground.
- If you're in a crowded public place, avoid panicking and do not rush for the exit. Stay low and cover your head and neck with your hands and arms.
