# Collision in town claims three lives



The aftermath of an accident that claimed the lives of three.

**Rustenburg** – A bakkie and a taxi collided on the corner of Beyers Naude Drive and Boshoff Street in the early hours of Saturday, 1 July 2017. The accident claimed the lives of three people, including both the drivers and one passenger of the bakkie.

The accident occurred at around 03h36 in the morning. The bakkie was travelling in Beyers Naude Drive and the taxi in Boshoff Street when the accident occurred. Three people were sitting in the front of the bakkie, of whom two didn't survive. The other person sustained serious injuries.

"The taxi and bakkie T-boned and the driver of the taxi was declared dead on scene," Weyland Bothma, base manager of Trauma Rescue, said. We offer our sincerest condolences to the families and friends of the deceased, as well as the injured parties.

## WOMAN FROM KOSTER KILLED

**Koster** – The North West provincial commissioner, lieutenant general Baile Motswenyane, condemned an incident in which a 30-year old man allegedly killed his 40-year old girlfriend. The incident occurred in Reagile near Koster on Friday, 30 June 2017. Upon arrival, the Police found the naked body of a woman on a bed. Emergency personnel certified the woman dead on scene. "According to information available at this stage, the suspect initially assaulted the woman in the street before they went inside the house where she was later found dead," sergeant Kelebogile Moleko, police spokesperson, said. The suspect appeared before the Koster Magistrates' Court on murder charges.



## SUSPECTED SERIAL RAPIST CAUGHT

**Rustenburg** – The Rustenburg Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences Unit (FCS) had a breakthrough when they arrested the elusive suspected serial rapist, Noah Kedige (41). Kedige was ready to pounce on the next victim when he was successfully traced and arrested on Tuesday, 4 July 2017, at the Siza informal settlement near Rustenburg. During his arrest, he was found in the possession of numerous Identity Documents (IDs) of women, which the Police suspect belong to his victims. He also had two bank cards and various clothing stores account cards. The accused is alleged to have lured his victims by promising them jobs. "Kedige would then take his victims to a secluded place to rape and rob them of their belongings. These crimes had been committed between April and June 2017 between the Siza Mine and Rustenburg East," sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, said. The accused appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 06 July 2017 on three charges of rape, two attempted rape and six of robbery. The arrest is seen as a meaningful stride towards solving rape cases in Rustenburg. Investigations into the matter continue and it is likely that Kedige may be linked to other cases. The police urge anyone with information regarding the incidents to contact the investigating officer, Mokgathe Mokgathe on 082-772 6453. The Rustenburg Cluster Commander, maj gen Adams commended the team for their commitment and tireless

efforts which resulted in the arrest of the suspect.

## HELP WITH IDENTIFICATION OF UNKNOWN BODIES

**Parys-Fochville** – The Police in Buffelshoek are requesting the community to assist in identifying two unknown and decomposed bodies that were found along the Parys-Fochville road, on Tuesday, 04 July 2017. "According to information available at this stage, it appears that the pair, both males, was shot in the back of their heads, execution style. The victims are estimated to be between the ages of 35 and 40. One of them was wearing a blue shirt. The other one was burnt beyond recognition, apparently due to the recent veld fire at the farm where they were found. At this stage the motive of the incident is unknown," brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, police spokesperson, said.
