He was district secretary of the Bafokeng District Football Association and was a member of the North West Central Executive Committee of the South Africa Football Association (SAFA). DYE-STAINED BANKNOTES IS A NO-NO

SA – The slogan, "A stained note is probably a stolen note", has not been more relevant than in the past few days since the looting in KwaZulu Natal and Gauteng. Visuals of looters vandalising ATMs circulated on social media.

• In a press release by Specialist Investigators into Serious Violent & Serious Economic Crimes, Mike Bolhuis, more than 1,400 ATMs were forced open during last week's looting spree.

The public is cautioned against accepting any dye-stained notes as legal tender because the onward use and value of these notes will not be honoured. Liquid dyes may stain the notes with a bluish-purple,

red, black or green colour. Such notes may give off a smell like that of paint initially and will stain fingers when touched. In a press statement by SABRIC, ATMs hold cash in special containers that protect cash with dye-stain technology that is activated when someone tries to break open the container. Once activated, the cash is stained with a green dye, thus defacing the notes, rendering them unusable as currency. SABRIC is a NPF company formed by South African banks to support the banking industry in combating crime.

Report any person in possession of dye-stained notes to the police on 0860 010 111.

Even for this innovative and bright young man, finding permanent employment is no easy task, but just sitting at home, doing nothing was not an option for him. Mike decided to put his skills and creativity to good use.

While working as an assistant boilermaker, he fell in love with the mining industry, where he learned a lot about the importance of safety in the workspace, being productive and innovative. So when his contract ended, he started designing a scale model underground locomotive. His locomotive has most of the features of a real underground locomotive and once he has installed its motor, it will be fully functional. He made a few adjustments to the carrier and reckons this easy 'tweak' would help to speed up the offloading process that should increase productivity. From the first design on paper to having a complete scale model took Mike only two weeks.

Another one of Mike's 'inventions' that left *Platinum Weekly* journalists in awe, is Mike's scale model shaft that moves up and down... complete with a conveyer belt and lights! The shaft was made with recycled material and an old fan motor that he found in a garbage bin. With this design he made a few adjustments like extra steps and storage containers that Mike says, will also contribute to safety and productivity. "I have so many ideas but don't have the money and the materials to build it," Mike said.

To get these designs noticed, he showcased them outside a local mine. In the meantime, he serves as Meriteng's local handyman by doing odd jobs. A few of Meriteng's residents are also boasting with his custom-made gates.

Mike said: "I love working with my hands and building things. I take great pride in my work and my dream is to see my ideas out in the world helping people."

The Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation & Tourism invites start-up and small business enterprises with duly registered companies/enterprises/cooperatives to apply for the Empowerment Fund. The objective of the Empowerment Fund is to support qualifying applicants with machinery and equipment to reduce their cost of doing business and improve their viability and competitiveness in the market.

Who can apply?

- Start-up business (businesses that have been operational for less than a year) may qualify for a maximum of R100 000.00, through the provision of production equipment and machinery including VAT, transport, installation and technical training costs.
- Existing businesses that have been operational for more than a year, may qualify for a maximum of up to R200 000.00 through the provision of production equipment and machinery including VAT, transport, installation and technical training costs.

Qualifying Criteria

- An applicant/applicants must be a South African citizen residing and operating a business in the North West Province.
- Be incorporated and registered in South Africa in terms of the Co-operatives Act No. 14 of 2005 and Company Act 71 of 2008 as amended.
- Must have attended business related training from any institution/agency for both start-ups and existing businesses.
- Must have a secured business operational site within the boundaries of the North West Province.
- The site must be used for its intended business purposes. Preference will be given to businesses owned by historically disadvantaged individuals (HDIs).
- Applicants must be directly involved in the business operations.

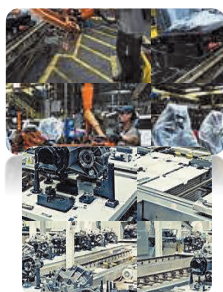

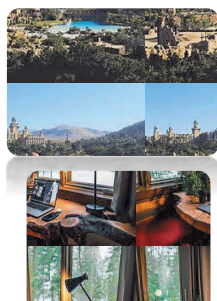

Mac and cheese balls

Rustenburg – Who doesn't love mac and cheese? This delicious comfort food can be turned into the ultimate munchy snack. Excalibur executive chef Michael van Deventer's parents spent a lot of time in the kitchen and that is where his passion for cooking began. He has since worked on cruise ships where he shared his amazing meals with people from all over the world. The last nine months he has settled at Excalibur Boutique Hotel.

Ingredients

- White sauce**
- 100g butter
 - 100g flour
 - 250ml milk
 - 250ml cream
 - 1 bay leaf
 - 3 cloves
 - 100g onion



Mac and cheese

- 250g macaroni
- 250g diced bacon
- 50g chopped jalapenos (optional)
- 150g grated mozzarella
- 150g grated cheddar
- 20g parmesan
- 100g breadcrumbs
- 4 eggs

Instructions

White sauce

1. In a medium-sized pot, melt the butter.
2. Add the flour and whisk until it forms a paste (called a roux).
3. Cook for about two minutes, remove from the pot and set aside.
4. In the same pot add the milk, onion, cloves and bay leaf and boil until the onion is soft.
5. Remove the cloves and bay leaf and add the cream.
6. Add chunks of the roux while continuously mixing it with a whisk until nice and thick.
7. Add salt and blend with a stick blender.
8. Let it cool completely.

Mac and cheese

1. Cook the macaroni for about 11 minutes and let it cool completely.
2. Chop a little bit just so that it can easily roll into a ball form.
3. Add the chopped macaroni, cooked white sauce, bacon, jalapenos and cheese together with salt to taste.
4. If the mixture is too soft, add cheese or breadcrumbs.
5. Roll the mixture into balls about the size of a golf ball.
6. Roll in the flour and egg, before rolling in seasoned breadcrumbs.
7. Deep fry until golden brown at 160°C.

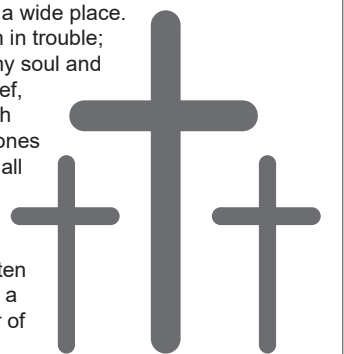
