ARMY OPERATION AGAINST ZAMA ZAMAS

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – The government's intensified crackdown on illegal mining and organised crime is now firmly under way, with the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) deployed to support police operations across several provinces, including North West. The deployment, authorised by President Cyril Ramaphosa, came into effect on 1 March 2026 and will run until 31 March 2027. It forms part of a national effort to stabilise crime hotspots and dismantle illegal mining networks linked to so-called *zama zamas*.

The deployment forms part of a broader, long-term strategy to curb illegal mining and restore stability in key economic regions — with Rustenburg now firmly on the map.

On 12 March 2026, the Department of Defence confirmed that SANDF members are working alongside the South African Police Service (SAPS) in a coordinated operation targeting illegal mining and gang-related activities in affected provinces. North West has been identified as one of the focus areas due to its extensive mining footprint. While early operations have been more visible in parts of Gauteng, the inclusion of North West places mining regions such as Rustenburg within the scope of the national intervention. Authorities say the operation aims to disrupt organised crime, recover illegal equipment and strengthen security around high-risk areas. For local communities, this may translate into an increased security presence, including patrols and roadblocks, particularly in and around mining zones and abandoned shafts.

Onalenna's case pushed to April 2026

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – The case surrounding the murder of North-West University (NWU) student Onalenna Selebogo (21) has been postponed once again. Sivenathi Gunya, communication officer for the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) in the North West Division, confirmed that the case against the accused, Walter Tshela, has now been postponed to 22 April 2026 for disclosure.

Tshela is accused of brutally murdering his girlfriend, Onalenna, whose body was discovered wrapped in sheets at a flat in Tuin Street, Rustenburg, on 3 August 2025. She had sustained multiple stab wounds to the neck. Students and staff at NWU have previously gathered in vigils to honour her life, calling for accountability and justice. Those who knew her remember Onalenna as a warm, driven young woman with a bright future ahead of her – a life full of promise that was cruelly cut short.

Gumbi murder case moves closer to trial

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – The long road to justice in the murder of respected businessman Ben Gumbi has taken another step, while the third accused in the case remains behind bars as the matter moves toward trial.

The National Prosecuting Authority (NPA), through its North West spokesperson Sivenathi Gunya, that the third suspect linked to Gumbi's killing has been remanded in custody until 27 March 2026, when the case is expected to proceed to trial.

This update follows earlier bail proceedings involving Zimele Mntuyazi Nkwanyana (37), who was arrested in Port Shepstone, KwaZulu-Natal, and later brought before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court. Nkwanyana first appeared in October 2025 as part of the broader investigation into Gumbi's murder in August 2023.

The case has already seen major developments. Two co-accused, Sibongiseni Ngubane (33) and Thabani Lethukuthula Gwala (30), were previously convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment for murder, along with an additional 15 years for possession of an unlicensed firearm. The sentences are running concurrently.

Ben Gumbi, aged 50, was fatally shot outside a Rustenburg coffee shop after stepping out of his vehicle to take a phone call, while his wife remained inside. Investigators were able to link the perpetrators to the crime through surveillance footage and fingerprint evidence, leading to swift arrests and successful prosecution. At the time, the NPA described the killing as "brutal, violent, and callous," underscoring the devastating impact the crime had on both the Gumbi family and the wider community.

MOB JUSTICE TURNS DEADLY IN FREEDOM PARK

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – Police have launched a murder investigation following a horrific vigilante-related incident in Freedom Park Phase 1 on Monday night, 16 March 2026. According to SAPS, officers responded to a complaint and discovered the burnt body of an unidentified man near a ventilation pipe in the informal settlement. The victim was declared dead on the scene. Preliminary reports suggest the attack may be linked to ongoing tensions and vigilante actions in the area, where groups have allegedly targeted individuals suspected of criminal activity. During the unrest, about five shacks were also reportedly set alight.

This follows a similar incident on 10 March, where two people were allegedly kidnapped, assaulted, and burned to death.

Acting Sub-district 2 commissioner, brigadier Mamotsamai Ntoagae, strongly condemned the violence, urging residents not to take the law into their own hands.

THREE YEARS AND COUNTING...

A Mother's Grief as Justice Is Delayed Again

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – More than three years after the murder of 31-year-old Caroline Werner, her family is once again forced to endure another painful delay in the pursuit of justice. The case against the accused, Solly Maledu, was postponed... again... this time to 30 March 2026.

According to National Prosecuting Authority spokesperson Sivenathi Gunya, the accused remains in custody.

For Caroline's mother, Ella Blackbeard, the postponement is another crushing blow in a journey marked by grief, exhaustion, and unanswered questions. "My heart is just broken," Ella said. "To sit in court and see him standing there with such arrogance is a bitter pill to swallow," she said. "After more than three years of going back and forth to court, we still have no answers — no why, no reason. And once again, it is postponed."

Caroline is remembered by those who loved her as a warm, vibrant woman with a contagious spirit. While time has moved on for the world around them, her family remains caught in a relentless cycle of court dates, delays, and grief.

Man Burned Alive in Suspected Mob Attack

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Mooiwooi – Police have launched investigations into a brutal murder and kidnapping following a shocking incident in which a 35-year-old Lesotho national was allegedly killed and set alight.

The incident occurred on Thursday night, 12 March 2026, at Khlamtwna, an informal settlement, where police responded to reports of a murder. According to sergeant Kelebogile Morake, officers arrived on scene and were met by a woman who identified herself as the deceased's girlfriend.

She informed police that she had received news that her boyfriend had been killed and left in nearby bushes. Upon approaching the scene, police observed flames burning and soon discovered the body of a naked male lying on the ground. His hands had been tied

behind his back, and his body had been set alight.

Preliminary investigations suggest that the victim was allegedly forcefully apprehended by a group of unknown community members, who accused him of stealing cattle.

The acting provincial commissioner of North West, major general (Dr) Ryno Naidoo, strongly condemned the incident, warning residents against taking the law into their own hands.

Investigations are ongoing, and no arrests have been made at this stage.

Our Ward Matters leads the change

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – Our Ward Matters (OWM) is proving that real change begins with action. Through regular clean-ups and hands-on community work, the team is transforming neglected spaces into cleaner, safer and more visible areas. Led by André van Dyk alongside Ward 17 councillor Tanya Rothman, the initiative continues to grow – already active in Wards 16 and 17 and now expanding into Ward 15. From cutting overgrown grass and clearing illegal dumping to improving visibility along busy routes, the team is tackling problem areas head-on.

Rolling up sleeves in the Rivers area
On 11 and 12 March 2026, Cllr Tanya Rothman led clean-up efforts across the Rivers area. Work began in Timbati, where grass was cut, an excavation hole was closed, and the area was restored for residents to enjoy. The team then moved through Usuturivier and continued the next day in Nylapies.

These high-traffic entry points to the neighbourhood now reflect a cleaner, more welcoming environment. A special word of thanks was extended to the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) Waste Department for providing a skip to support the clean-up.

Tackling hidden dangers and illegal dumping

On 16 March, the team focused on the heavily overgrown area at the corner of Pendorong and Waterboom Avenue. What was once a concealed and unsafe space – where people could hide in dense bushes – was cleared to restore visibility and safety. Working along Pendorong Bridge and towards Kurkbos

Avenue, the team removed large volumes of illegal dumping and cut back vegetation by up to four metres. The transformation was immediate and impactful. The team also acknowledged AGS Deo Gloria Church for consistently maintaining the area in front of their premises – an example of community pride in action.

Restoring dignity, one street at a time
On 17 March, OWM continued the clean-up from Pendorong Bridge through Waterboom and Kurkbos Avenue, finishing at Koorsboom and Willow Avenue. Using spades, brushcutters, rakes and pangas, the team cleared stormwater drains, removed invasive overgrowth and collected litter throughout the area.

Expanding impact across Ward 17
On 18 March, the team moved to Watervalrivier near the canal – an area requiring ongoing maintenance. Work included cutting dense grass and clearing bush towards the Krokodilrivier and Helen Joseph areas. Additional teams tackled litter hotspots along Waterberg towards Builders, and in the Cuckoo area towards the BP Garage on the R24. The momentum continues, with more areas scheduled for attention in the coming days.








Did you know?
